SPARKLING WINE & CHAMPAGNE

- Cava Castell d'Olerdola Brut Rosé** Spain NV £21.10
A blend of perfumed Grenache and fruit-laden Monastrell, this rosé Cava has a delicate tight mousse with a persistent yet creamy soft texture. Delicious.
- Prosecco Valdobbiadene Brut 'Jeio', Bisol** Italy NV £25.50
A deliciously light and elegant style of Prosecco, with delicate citrus fruit and crisp lemon acidity. Bottled under less pressure than Champagne, it is the perfect aperitif.
- Beaumont des Crayeres, Grande Reserve** Champagne NV £43.35
Half Bottle £24.00
An excellent complex Champagne packed with rich fruit flavours with a biscuity, almost yeasty note on the nose and palate. A fine mousse and very pleasing long finish.
- Taittinger, Brut Reserve** Champagne NV £49.95
Pale straw in colour, with a light and delicate bouquet with hints of biscuit and brioche. The palate is delicate, yet has considerable depth with a long fresh finish.

WHITE WINE

- Finca La Linda Unoaked Chardonnay, Luigi Bosca** Argentina 2007 £15.10
Ripe & intense fruit character of peach, pear & apple, with a rounded palate and good balancing acidity.
- Fiano Mandrarossa, Cantine Settesoli, Sicily** Italy 2007 £16.15
An interesting alternative to Pinot Grigio, this award-winning Fiano is clean and fresh with a lovely balance of ripe fruit and mineral-tinged acidity.
- Snapper Point Verdelho** S Australia 2006 £16.75
A crisp, fruity, dry white with citrus and tropical fruit notes.
- The Ruins Chardonnay/Viognier, Robertson** S. Africa 2008 £17.80
A smooth blend of aromatic ripe peach fruit from the Viognier and freshness and body from the Chardonnay. The texture is soft and creamy with the palate perfectly balanced.

- 9 **Touraine Sauvignon Blanc, Domaine de Chezelles** Loire 2007 £18.95
A delicate yet alluring Sauvignon with elderflower, nettles and grass on the nose, and a fresh, attractive palate that would better most 'bargain' Sancerre.
- 10 **Villa Wolf Pinot Gris, J L Wolf** Germany 2007 £19.15
Produced by German superstar Ernst Loosen, just over the German border from Alsace, this fruity, off-dry and impeccably balanced wine is a shining example of its type.
- 11 **Billi Billi Pinot Grigio, Mount Langhi, Victoria** Australia 2007 £20.50
Peach & lime fruit and a full, almost creamy texture makes this Aussie take on an Italian classic a great choice to please a variety of palates.
- 12 **Pinot Blanc Reserve, Hunawihl** Alsace 2004 £20.75
Deliberately edging towards off-dry, rich and fragrant on the nose, with a weighty viscosity yet still punctuated by clean fresh acidity.
- 13 **Soave Classico 'Monte Tenda', Tedeschi** Italy 2007 £23.20
Made from 100% Garganega, this wine displays complexity and layers of aromatic & herbaceous notes with a hint of almond on the finish. Rich, yet soft in texture.
- 14 **Wild South Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough** New Zealand 2007 £23.50
Archetypal award-winning Sauvignon showing intense gooseberry & passionfruit flavours with a zingy acidity.
- 15 **Gundian Albariño, Adegas Valdes** Spain 2006 £23.95
A beautifully fresh, delicate & aromatic wine exhibiting the very best that the Albariño grape has to offer.
- 16 **Kayena Estate Riesling, Tamar Ridge** Tasmania 2006 £24.40
A fabulous dry Riesling from fruit grown in their prime vineyard. The citrus and lime are textbook Riesling and the mineral-tinged acidity provides backbone. Full flavoured and expressive, yet elegant at the same time.
- 17 **Sancerre Chêne du Roy, Domaine Girault** Loire 2007 £26.40
A very classic Sancerre displaying an elegant, restrained fruit character with well-balanced stony acidity and a terrific finish.
- 18 **Chablis, Domaine Billaud-Simon** Burgundy 2006 £27.05
Classic Chablis with tight mineral aromas and a crisp yet deliciously persistent palate. The concentration on such a crisp wine is outstanding. Fantastic with fish and light meat dishes.
- 19 **Planeta Chardonnay, Planeta, Sicily** Italy 2006 £34.30
The robust and brilliantly oaked palate displays a rich, nutty and aromatic character more reminiscent of good Californian whites. A truly memorable drinking experience.
- 20 **Puligny Montrachet 'Vieilles Vignes', Girardin** Burgundy 2004 £43.70
Toasty vanilla notes on the nose build on the palate with a varietal characteristic and natural acidity ensuring the wine finishes with perfect harmony and balance. French oak used to compliment rather than overwhelm naturally concentrated fruit.

ROSÉ WINE

- 21 **Côtes du Luberon Rosé, 'Marrenon Classic'** Rhone 2006 £15.80
With subtle flavours of pink grapefruit & morello cherry, this Grenache/Syrah/Cinsault blend is quite delightful with a prolonged finish
- 22 **Sancerre Rosé, 'Le Grand Fricambault'** Loire 2006 £28.65
A very elegant rosé made from 100% Pinot Noir, hence the colour. Showing restraint and yet unmistakable Burgundian tones, this is ideal with poultry and fish dishes.

RED WINE

- 23 **Cabernet Sauvignon, Julio Bouchon** Chile 2006 £15.95
Blackcurrant fruit with herbaceous notes; a typically full-bodied Cabernet Sauvignon.
- 24 **Montepulciano d'Abruzzo, Umani Ronchi** Italy 2007 £16.65
With an abundance of red cherry fruit, nice tingly freshness and good structure, this is a good example of clean, fruit-driven, medium-bodied Montepulciano.
- 25 **Alicante, Domaine Fontareche, VdP de l'Aude** S France 2007 £16.95
Offering plenty of fruit, with good tannins and a fresh ripe bouquet, this has remarkable depth and would be a good match with roasted meats.
- 26 **La Petite Ferme 'Maison Rouge', Franschhoek** S Africa 2007 £17.55
From the famous Petite Ferme restaurant & vineyard, a blend of Shiraz & Cabernet displaying eucalyptus, bay, cedar, cassis & spice. Unmistakably South African and great with poultry & game.
- 27 **Rioja Tinto Sin, Bodegas Navajas, Navarette** Spain 2007 £17.80
This expressive young Rioja shows an attractive violet-scented nose with hints of clove and spice. A beautifully rounded palate with just a little oak adds depth, complexity and support to the long balanced finish.
- 28 **Chateau du Charnay, Macon Rouge** Burgundy 2007 £18.45
Made from 100% Gamay, this pale cherry red wine shows raspberry, gooseberry, blackberry and some spicy notes on the nose, with a nice presence of fruits and subtle tannins on the palate. Best served very lightly chilled.
- 29 **Commissioner's Block Shiraz/Viognier** S Australia 2006 £19.25
The depth of ripe blackberry fruit is given a touch of perfumed softness from the addition of 2% Viognier to the blend – a technique used in Côte Rotie for many years.
- 30 **Wente Merlot, Monterey** California 2003 £21.80
Showing a good depth of ripe, plummy fruit with hints of chocolate and spice, this versatile wine is soft and rounded with gentle tannins and great length.
- 31 **Kayena Estate Pinot Noir, Tamar Ridge** Tasmania 2005 £24.90
This stunning wine has deep strawberry and mulberry fruit on the nose with hints of spicy oak, which gives way to an intense, rounded and mouth-filling palate of cherry and red berry fruit with a warm, subtle spiciness to the long finish.

- 32 **L'Enclos du Lezongars** Bordeaux 2001 £26.45
Highly acclaimed and very showy Claret with a high percentage of Cabernet Sauvignon and fully ripened Merlot selected from old vines. Weighty and persistent on the nose and palate with a continual complimentary backbone of fine grain oak.
- 33 **Rosso di Montalcino, Val di Suga, Tenimenti Angelini** Italy 2004 £27.55
100% Sangiovese which sees 15 months ageing in oak, resulting in a rich, powerful yet very approachable wine with a velvety character & a great degree of elegance.
- 34 **Urbina Rioja Seleccion Crianza** Spain 1998 £29.75
A very classic, old-fashioned style of Rioja. Ripe cherry and strawberry scents with lovely tobacco overtones from extensive ageing in barrel. Very smooth and long on the palate.
- 35 **Château Cissac, Cru Borgeois Haut Medoc** Bordeaux 2000 £33.80
A truly great Claret displaying the classic hallmarks of tobacco, cigar box and cedarwood with a slight eucalyptus tinge to the medium-bodied blackcurrant fruit. This is a great wine from a great year that is drinking beautifully now.
- 36 **Barolo Arione, Gigi Rosso** Italy 2004 £34.45
Low production and hand selection achieves an amazing concentration of fruit, complemented by intense dried herb, mineral & leather notes. A classic, elegant Barolo with a distinguished & delicate bouquet and a rich, complex and smooth body.
- 37 **Gevrey Chambertin, Lucien Boillot** Burgundy 2005 £39.75
Very complex, medium-bodied wine seeing 25% new oak with cherry fruit and a deal of mushroom/peat moss.

HALF BOTTLES

Champagne

- 38 **Beaumont des Crayeres, Grande Reserve** Champagne NV £24.00
An excellent complex Champagne, packed with rich fruit flavours with a biscuity, almost yeasty note on the nose and palate. A fine mousse and very pleasing long finish.

White wines

- 39 **Dr Loosen Riesling** Germany 2006 £10.05
Made by Ernst Loosen, Decanter Winemaker of the Year. Typical Mosel Riesling harmony of delicate fruit & acidity.
- 40 **Montes Sauvignon Blanc** Chile 2006 £11.60
A fresh, elegant Sauvignon with great varietal character.
- 41 **Jurançon Sec, Cuvée Marie, Charles Hours** SW France 2005 £14.25
Made from 90% Gros Manseng and 10% Petit Courbu, this is a wonderfully complex and concentrated wine.

- 42 **Chablis 1er Cru, Billaud-Simon** Burgundy 2005 £16.45
 Floral, lifted and intense, with greengages and citrus zest and a hint of underlying earthy richness. This brilliant Chablis has very focussed fruit that is taut & pure with a stony character. Long finish.

Red wines

- 43 **Rasteau, Cave de Rasteau** S. Rhone 2006 £10.75
 Fruit-laden Southern Rhone with vibrance, complexity, pepper and spice. Wonderful with game and dark meats.
- 44 **Montecillo Cumbre Crianza Rioja** Spain 2003 £12.75
 A superb Rioja, deep and full-bodied with dark berry fruit and forward spice flavours from the new oak.
- 45 **Chateau Musar** Lebanon 2000 £16.35
 From the eccentric Gaston Hochar, this is Lebanon's finest estate. Like a Chateauneuf du Pape, this is a heavy, spicy wine with heady rich fruit and a long bittersweet finish.

DESSERT WINE

- 46 **Rutherglen Muscat, Campbell** Australia NV £15.75
Half bottle (375ml) 75ml glass £3.95
 Probably one of the most honeyed and concentrated dessert wine on the market. Made from shrivelled grapes, this rich, amber-gold wine is full of raisin and apricot aromas.
- 47 **Loupiac, Domaine de Noble** Bordeaux 2003 £16.35
Half bottle (375ml) 75ml glass £4.10
 Full and honeyed with a distinctive mineral note, this botrytised wine is made from selective hand-harvested, barrique-aged Semillon (70%) and Sauvignon (30%).
- 48 **Kayena Estate Botrytis Riesling, Tamar Ridge** Tasmania 2006 £18.70
Half bottle (375ml) 75ml glass £4.70
 Luscious, up-front fruit delivering a great mouthfeel, with lively balanced acidity keeping the wine fresh & uncloying.
