RED WINES

13. Casa de Piedra Cabernet Sauvignon

A big, full-bodied wine with cherry, cassis and vanilla notes

14. Aresti Estate Selection Merlot – Chile 13.5%

A Merlot with deep purple colour, complex fruit, herbal and minty aromas. On the palate, the fresh fruit characters are vivid and spicy with rich notes of blackberry jam.

15. Capell's Court Cabernet Sauvignon – South Africa 13%

This red wine is packed with fruit and lightly oaked. Red and black fruit aromas are mirrored on the pallet. The full ripe fruit gives this wine an innate complexity.

16. Witt's End Shiraz – Australia 13%

A great example of Australian Shiraz. Deep red in colour, and packed with aromas of spices, blackberries, vanilla and liquorice. Dry and soft to taste with full and pleasing length.

17. Domaine Lucien Tardieu Beaujolais AOC – Burgundy

Bright ruby red colour. Floral and elegant bouquet evoking scents of violet. On the palate, nicely structured and supple with fresh, fruity notes. An elegant and well balanced wine.

18. Stonehedge Cellars Zinfandel – California 13.5%

A small family wine producer of high quality handcrafted wines. Peppery blackberry and ripe cherry pie flavours backed with a spicey juicy finish.

19. Rocca di Castagnoli Chianti Classico DOCG – Italy 12.5%

A wine of excellent complexity and structure. The colour is intense ruby-red with purple reflections. The wine has an intense bouquet, rich in fruity and winy hints and a captivating balsamic note. The period in wood gives a notable balance to the wine and silky, smooth tannins on the palate.

20. Venato Valpolicella DOC Superiore, 'Ripassa' – Italy 13.5%

The wine has a ruby red colour, delicate almond bouquet and a dry, velvety flavour.

An outstanding example of how good Valpolicella can be.

21. Dinastia Vivanco Rioja Reserva

Rich aromas of ripe fruit, vanilla and spice. Good backbone with soft fruit and well integrated toasty oak flavours.

22. Balnaves Cabernet Sauvignon 1998 Australia 13.5%

This is a huge wine of epic proportions, James Halliday rates this as the best Cabernet Sauvignon to come out of Australia—very limited quantities with serious cult status.

23. Les Tourelles de Longueville Pauillac

Deep in colour with real Pauillac class on the nose: cedar spice, blackcurrants and plums with an ever so slightly savoury edge. The palate is medium-body with ripe, firm tannins bracketing the pure plum and cassis fruit and sensibly handled oak.

25. Marche Rosato IGT, Rosapina' – Italy

A muted salmon pink colour with an intense fresh and fruity bouquet and an elegant, gentle taste.

26. Domaine d'Astros Rose Vin de Pays des Maures

A gentle, dry rose with subtle raspberry and cherry aromas. The palate is bright and fresh with the fruit balanced perfectly by the crisp acidity in the finish.

WHITE WINES

1. La Croix Blanc Coteaux d'Enserune

Intense nose of white flowers, juicy peaches and vanilla pods. The palate is full and well balanced with lively fruit and a refreshing finish.

2. Aresti Estate Selection Sauvignon Blanc – Chile

The Curico Valley has long been recognised as a leading region for Sauvignon Blanc and is a perfect example. Intensely fruity with tropical fruit notes on the nose with refreshing mango and maracuya flavours on the palate that are balanced by light herbal characters.

3. Libertad Pinot Blanc

Aromas of stone fruit predominate, with discreet vibrant feel. Rounded and fresh, this wine shows great balance.

4. Cantina di Custoza Pinot Grigio Garda DOC – Italy

The grapes are harvested from 5 to 8 year old vines in vineyards located in S.Giorgio in Salici. Fresh and fruity with a clean and crisp taste. Pleasant length.

5. Witt's End Unoaked Chardonnay – Australia

Vibrant, pale yellow in colour. The wine has a truly varietal nose showing intense aromas of lychee and red rose petals. It displays intense aromatic and floral notes.

6. La Garene, Entre-Deux-Mer AC – Bordeaux

A beautiful white green-tinted wine with elegant fruity aromas.

7. Gavi Tenimenti Ca'Bianca

Fresh as a daisy wine from the cortese grape. Great in the summer with grilled chicken and salads.

Spy Valley Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc

8. Valserrano Barrel Fermented Rioja Blanco DOCa – Rioja

Rich, creamy, soft fruity style Rioja, full of elegance and charm. Citrus character on the palate and a persistent, rounded finish thanks to its time in oak.

9. San Michele Appiano sauvignon Blanc 'Lahn' DOC – Italy

Delicious strong aromas of elderberry and honey. A long and pleasant finish.

10. Chablis Lucien Tardieu AOC – Burgundy

The Lucien Tardieu Chablis has wonderful ripe fruit aromas of summer flowers and the distinctive mineral character of great Chablis. Crisp, refreshing and satisfyingly long. Perfect as an aperitif or with oysters, seafood such as baked white fish and crudités and charcuterie.

11. Pouilly Fuisse La Croix Domaine Robert Denogent

Concentrated mineral notes on the nose add to the lemony, peach fruit. The palate is elegant & balanced with delicious weight of fruit, more minerality & a spine of finely grained acidity.
